<p>He is a doctor. (He is a doctor.)</p>	<p>She is a doctor. (She is a doctor.)</p>

<p>We are doctors. (We are doctors.)</p>	<p>They are doctors. (They are doctors.)</p>
<p>It is a boy. (It is a boy.)</p>	<p>They are children. (They are children.)</p>

Grammar Focus (Grammar Focus)



- ❖ You use **"I am..."** (I am...) to refer to yourself (the speaker or writer).
- ❖ You use **"You are..."** (You are...) to refer to the person in front of you (the listener or reader). "You" can refer to one person or more than one person. It is usually clear from the context whether "you" is singular or plural.
- ❖ You use **"He is..."** (He is...) to refer to a man.
- ❖ You use **"She is..."** (She is...) to refer to a woman.
- ❖ You use **"It is..."** (It is...) to refer to things/animals.
- ❖ You use **"We are..."** (We are...) to refer to different groups of people, but always including the speaker.
- ❖ You use **"They are..."** (They are...) to refer to specific groups of people, things and animals.
