Grammar Focus (Grammar Focus)

- ❖ You use **"I + (verb)"** (I + (verb)) to refer to your action.
- ❖ You use **"You + (verb)"** (You + (verb)) to refer to the action of the person (singular) or people (plural) you are talking to.
- ❖ You use **"He + (verb)"** (He + (verb)) to refer to the action of a man. The form of the verb changes by adding "s" or "es" at the end of a verb.
- ❖ You use **"She + (verb)"** (She + (verb)) to refer to the action of a woman. The form of the verb changes by adding "s" or "es" at the end of a verb.
- ❖ You use **"It + (verb)"** (It + (verb)) to refer to the action of an object/animal. The form of the verb changes by adding "s" or "es" at the end of a verb.
- ❖ You use **"We + (verb)"** (We + (verb)) to refer to the action of different groups of people, but always including the speaker.
- ❖ You use **"They + (verb)"** (They + (verb)) to refer to the action of specific groups of people, things and animals.
