Reading (Reading)

I **have** a car.
(I have a car.)

We **have** a meeting.
(We have a meeting.)

You **have** two children.
(You have two children.)

They **have** dinner.
(They have dinner.)

I **have** a question.
(I have a question.)

We **have** a pet.
(We have a pet.)

<p>He has a shower every day. (He has a shower every day.)</p>	<p>She has a party every weekend. (She has a party every weekend.)</p>
<p>He has three brothers. (He has three brothers.)</p>	<p>She has lunch. (She has lunch.)</p>
<p>He has questions. (He has questions.)</p>	<p>She has English lessons every day. (She has English lessons every day.)</p>

Grammar Focus (Grammar Focus)

- ❖ **Have, has** (have, has) are useful words that you can use in various situations.
- ❖ "Have, has" are verbs that usually show possession ("I have a car"). They can also be used to show action ("I have a shower every day").
- ❖ You can have a meeting, class, sibling, question, time, etc.
