## Grammar focus (Grammar focus)

- ❖ Put “will” before the subject instead of “do” or “does” when you make an interrogative sentence. Use WH-question words (what, where, when, how, etc.) at the beginning of a sentence followed by will to make questions as well.

E.g.) Will you arrive on time? (Will you arrive on time?)

What will you do tomorrow? (What will you do tomorrow?)
