Warm-up | Useful Expressions

Directions: Listen and repeat.

- **fitting room** – a room where you can try clothes on before buying them
- **on sale** – available for sale at reduced prices
- **out of stock** – temporarily unavailable for sale
- **try on** – to put clothes on to find out whether they fit or not

- **May I help you?**
- **I'm just looking, thank you.**
- **What size are you looking for?**
- **It doesn't fit.**
- **Do you have this in one size larger?**
- **Can I try it on?**
- **I'll take it.**
- **Thank you for your assistance.**
