Warm-up | Useful Expressions

Directions: Listen and repeat.

- **May I take your order, please?**
 - Yes, could I have a cappuccino?
 - Yes, could I have an espresso?

- **Would you like short, tall or grande size?**
 - Tall, please.
 - Short, please.

- **What flavor would you like?**
 - Vanilla, please.
 - Hazelnut, please.

- **Would you like a pastry?**
 - I'll have a cinnamon roll.
 - I'll have a muffin.

- **Will that be for here or to go?**
 - For here, please.
 - To go, please.

- **Will that be to dine in or take-out?**
 - To dine in, please.
 - To take-out, please.

Activity 1 | Dialogue 1

Directions: Read the dialogue aloud with your teacher.

Jim is at a coffee shop, about to order something.

Counter Clerk: Good morning! **May I take your order?**

Jim: Yes. **Could I have** a cappuccino, please?

Counter Clerk: Sure. **Would you like short, tall or grande size?**

Jim: **Tall**, please.

Counter Clerk: **What flavor would you like?**

Jim: **I'll have** vanilla with mocha topping.

Counter Clerk: **Would you like some pastry?**

Jim: **I'd go for** a cinnamon roll.

Counter Clerk: Would that be all?

Jim: Yes.

Counter Clerk: **Would that be for here or to go?**

Jim: For here, please.

Counter Clerk: Okay. That'll be \$7.70 in total.

Jim: Here's \$8.00

Counter Clerk: Here's your change. You can pick up your order from the next counter.

2. How much did Jim pay for his order?
3. Did he get any change? How much?
