Warm-up | Useful Expressions

Directions: Listen and repeat.

- **be into something** - to be interested in something in an active way
- **keep up with something** - to continue to be informed about something
- **choosy** - careful in choosing, difficult to please.
- **superb** - excellent, of very good quality

(**outstanding, perfect, superb**: all these describe something that is extremely good)

- **freak** - a person with a very strong interest in a particular subject.

e.g.) a fitness freak, a jazz freak, a health freak, etc.
