

## Lesson 18: Looking for a Restaurant

### Warm-up | Useful Expressions

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**Directions:** Listen and repeat.

- **lose one's way** – to become lost, unable to find your way
- **Go straight up the street**
- **Go down the street**
- **Turn left at the corner**
- **Turn right at the corner**
- **Chinese / Italian / French / Mexican / Japanese restaurant**
- **Chinese / Italian / French / Mexican / Japanese food**
- **cuisine** - a style or method of cooking, especially as characteristic of a particular country

## Activity 1 | Dialogue 1

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**Directions:** Read the dialogue aloud with your teacher.

*Andy is looking for a restaurant.*

**Andy** : Excuse me, is this Masterson Street?

**Gentleman** : Yes, it is. This is the corner of Mission Street and Pine Street.

**Andy** : Thank you. I just came out from the train station. I don't want to **lose my way**.

**Gentleman** : I see. Where do you want to go?

**Andy** : Rose Street. I've heard that there are many nice restaurants. I'm looking for a place to eat.

**Gentleman** : That's easy. **Go straight up** Masterson Street and **turn left** at the next corner. **Go down** the street and **turn right** at the third corner. You'll be on Rose Street.

**Andy** : Oh, thank you! By the way, what kind of restaurants are there?

**Gentleman** : Many different kinds. There are some nice **Chinese restaurants** for example.

**Andy** : I see, but I don't feel like eating **Chinese food** now...

**Gentleman** : What about **French food**? Do you like it?

**Andy** : Yes, I do like it very much.

**Gentleman** : I recommend *Natary's Restaurant* there. It serves good French **cuisine**.

**Andy** : Thank you so much. I'll find the restaurant there.

2. How can Andy get to Rose Street from where he is right now?
3. Where is Andy going to have lunch?
