

## Lesson 25: Weathercast

Hi! How are you today?

Today's lesson is about "*Weathercast.*"

Have fun learning English!

### Warm-up | Useful Expressions

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- **What's the weather going to be like?**
- **weathercast** - a weather forecast, especially one broadcast by radio or television
- **foggy** - not clear because of fog
- **rainy** - having or bringing a lot of rain
- **stormy** - with strong winds and heavy rain or snow
- **sunny** - with a lot of bright light from the sun
- **clear** - without cloud or mist
- **drizzly** - wet with light rain
- **showery** - with frequent showers of rain

## Activity 1 | Dialogue 1

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**Directions:** Read the dialogue aloud with your teacher.

*Mae and Sally are talking about going to the beach.*

**Mae :** I'd really like to go to the beach sometime this week.

**Sally :** I'd like to join you! **What's the weather going to be like?**

**Mae :** Okay, I will check. It will be **foggy** tomorrow, **rainy** the day after tomorrow, **stormy** this weekend.

**Sally :** Oh my... I don't think it's good to go there.

**Mae :** I don't think so, either.

**Sally :** How about next weekend?

**Mae :** Let me check the monthly **weathercast**. It will be **sunny** and **clear** next weekend.

**Sally :** Nice! So we're going to go to the beach next week?

**Mae :** Oh, I forgot! I was told to attend the meeting next weekend! How about the end of this month? I'll be free then.

**Sally :** It says the weather will be getting bad again after the next week. It'll be **drizzly** and **showery** in spots.

**Mae :** I think we should postpone the plan until next month.

**Sally :** Yeah. Maybe next time.

2. What will the weather be like next weekend?
3. What will the weather be like after the next weekend?
