*Scene: Mr. Thomas asks a flight attendant about onboard instructions just in case.*

**Flight attendant:** Yes, they are under your seat. Your **seat cushion** can also be used as a **flotation device**.

**Mr. Thomas:** I'm afraid the weather is not so good. What can I do to stay safe?

**Flight attendant:** You don't need to worry about it. Always make sure that your **seatbelt is fastened** when the seatbelt sign is turned on.
